The position will spend time in the Topsham quality control lab, on Crooker job sites, and gathering material to test from other Crooker locations.

When in the field the Technician will be responsible for monitoring HMA density, placement and temperatures, generating reports, and working with/directing paving crews to produce consistent and high-quality results on each project. While in the lab and at other facilities the Technician will be responsible for gathering and testing samples of aggregate and hot mix asphalt (HMA) to ensure the material being produced meets or exceeds specification, tracking test results, generating reports, and communicating results with the quality control team as well as other Crooker employees.

Most of the work will be done independently but there are times when the selected candidate will be required to work as a team to ensure a high-quality product is being produced.

Previous experience working with aggregate and/or HMA materials is required. NETTCP certification is a plus. We are willing to train the right person.

- Must have good math skills and the ability to perform standard laboratory tests in accordance with AASHTO and ASTM procedures.
